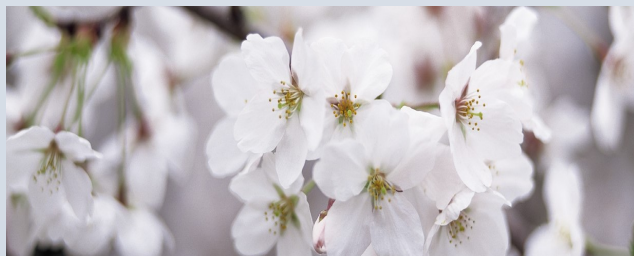


## Guardians for Galloway Ridge Society
